



Tips and Best Practices

- Priority would be to place fishing line recycle bins close to where people are fishing, landing their boats, or walking to and from, for convenience.
- If possible, co-locate with a trash can to minimize the trash that goes in the fishing line recycle bin.
- Include some type of lid to limit litter in the fishing line recycle bin and to keep animals out.
- Have a schedule to inspect and empty the recycle bin. The more fishing traffic the more often they should be inspected.
- Keep the fishing line recycle bin as clean as possible to help ensure its use.
- Place identifying and informational signage and decals on containers and replace as needed. Focus on what to put in the container, rather than what not to put in it.
- Remove hooks, lures, and other debris when sending off the materials to be recycled.
- Utilize appropriate PPE when handling the collected fishing line.
